### Sedley Court

Sedley Court is a modern residence complex for 150 younger students (generally aged 18-24), with a lively international atmosphere. It is owned by Anglia Ruskin University and is used by university students from September to June. Bell has 15 rooms for the summer, comprising 3 flats, each with 5 study-bedrooms. Sedley Court is close to a regular city bus route from Bell to the City Centre. It is also within a few minutes' walk of a local supermarket and cafes.

### Cambridge

Cambridge is a beautiful historic university city, with cinemas, art galleries, theatre, fashionable cafes and bars, restaurants, pubs, the market place and many shops. The Cambridge Leisure Centre is located between the city centre and the School and has a cinema, bowling, fitness centre, cafes, club and bar. In the centre of Cambridge there is also Parkside swimming pool and sports centre and the Grafton Centre with many shops, 8 screen cinema and several cafes and restaurants.

Cambridge is famous for its wonderful architecture and college buildings and students can enjoy the delights of punting on the River Cam, shopping or sightseeing around the many colleges.

### Accommodation

The campus-style accommodation in Sedley Court Residence is non-smoking and is suitable for younger independent students aged 18+ who enjoy living in a lively student campus and who are happy to make their own arrangements for meals. We do not generally recommend Sedley Court for more mature students

Accommodation is in attractive single study-bedrooms with private shower room and toilet. Each flat of 5 study-bedrooms has a shared well-equipped kitchen, supplied with crockery, cutlery, fridge, freezer and cooking facilities.



Students at Sedley Court are expected to make their beds, keep their rooms tidy, and to share responsibility for keeping the kitchen clean and tidy. Rooms are cleaned weekly and bed linen is provided weekly, but you will need to bring your own towels. Internet access is available for an extra charge of approximately £25 payable direct to Sedley on arrival

### Security

Sedley Court operates a CCTV system on the site and each student has a key to their flat and to their bedroom. Students will be responsible for the cost of any lost keys or entry cards.

### Non-smoking residence

Please note that Sedley Court is **non-smoking** and smoking is not allowed anywhere in the Residence.

### Meals and laundry

Sedley Court is self-catering with no meals provided, making it an attractive option for students who wish to be more independent and make their own arrangements for meals. A wide selection of lunches, drinks and snacks are available at the main Bell School from 0830 to 1600 Monday to Friday.

Sedley Court has its own laundrette with washing machines and dryers. Irons and ironing boards are available in the kitchens in the Residence.

### Lessons and facilities at Bell Cambridge

Lessons are at the Bell School, located in an elegant manor house in its own extensive gardens in a residential area of Cambridge. Sports facilities include football field, 2 tennis courts, basketball and volleyball courts and a Sports Pavilion with table tennis and pool tables and television.

### Transport

Sedley Court is close to a Citi bus route between Bell Cambridge and the city centre and students can buy a Megarider Bus Ticket for approximately £11 a week.
